We may use "cookies" to track usage on our site. Cookies are not linked in any way to your personal information. Cookies can be blocked in your browser's security settings.

We may use website server log information to statistically monitor how many people are using our site. Log is automatically reported by your browser each time you access a web page.

Only authorized personnel have access to the server logs and cookie utilization data we potentially would collect.
